Extra-Curricular Activities

Enrolment for Term **2, 2011**

Return the enrolment form by: **Friday 15th April 2011 or MAIL BY: Friday 15th April 2011**

Placements will be first in, gets in.

Once again the time has come to think about extra-curricular activities after school program. We are now ready to enrol children in activities for Term **2, 2011**. **Please note** ALL enrolments must be with the Co-ordinators by the above dates. Enrolments may be posted to the above address. If numbers permit we will organise the listed activities on the days indicated. **PLEASE ENROL BEFORE END OF TERM. Enrolments will NOT be accepted after week 1 (or the first week of the activities starting).**

The activities will not be conducted on Public Holidays, week 1 of Term 1 and week 10 of Term 4.

The activities **BEGIN week One (1) Monday 2nd May**
Last day Friday 8th July

Activities will begin at 3.30 pm. Children are required to report to the Co-ordinators near the Canteen (steps to oval) straight after school, so that the rolls can be marked before they proceed to activities.

All activities last one hour. **Children must be COLLECTED PROMPTED after activities at 4.30pm**, unless they continue in the After School Care Program.

Prompt collection of children after the activity is a **condition of enrolment**. If children are not collected from the activity **they will be kept near the ASC office/desk for collection**, and **NOT BE ALLOWED** to wait for parents near the playground equipment.

Assume your child has been enrolled in the activities you have selected and have paid for unless you are informed to the contrary.

Kindergarten children will be collected from their classrooms and taken to activities, during the first few weeks in Term 1.

Fees The fee for any course is only refundable under exceptional circumstances.

ASC rates relates only to a child enrolled in After School Program on that day. This discount applies due to shared staffing arrangements.

Fees are **to be PAID IN FULL** before the end of the first week in the Term. Please make cheques payable to TPS P&C After School Program, credit card facilities are available. **Please return the enrolment form and payment** to Julie Sheedy or Director or in an envelope addressed to the Director and left at the ASC Program office **by Friday 15th April 2011** or received by post **by Friday 15th April 2011**

English homework

This class provides a chance for children to gain assistance with their English homework.

French homework

Students are immersed in a French atmosphere, speaking in French, and doing their French homework. Two different skill levels are provided: years 1—2 and years 3—6.

French Reading and Games

As with French homework, the class is immersed in the French language, however, the focus is on books, games and activities rather than specific homework tasks.

Art

Children partake in a variety of artistic experiences such as drawing, painting and prints. Each activity is suited to a variety of children's skill levels. This activity does not include any craft.

Textiles

Children will create with fabric to do weaving, felt work and other creative textiles. Materials provided, and children can take their work home.

Cooking

Children will help create delicious meals and treats and be given recipes so they can recreate these delights for you and your family. They will experience cooking a variety of different cultural meals, which may include Italian, Thai and French.

Auskick Football

Coaches from Auskick will come and teach children footie skills and play games, catering to children of all ages. Price of this activity includes an Auskick Pack (backpack, football, beanie and more!) Boys and girls welcome.

Dance Street Funk

Students are taught fun and funky moves which all come together as a great routine at the end of the term that they can perform for the rest of the After School Care Program.

Kung Fu

Children learn moves from this sport in a relaxed, non-threatening environment with children of similar ages. The classes are split into year groups K—2 and 3—6.

Milo Cricket

Children will be taught cricket skills and play games, catering to children of all ages. Boys and girls welcome.

Soccer

Children will be taught soccer skills and engage in soccer games out on one of the school fields. This opportunity is open to children of all ages.

Tennis

Two qualified teachers come to the school and take a group of children to the tennis courts across the road. The group is split into two different skill levels to learn the various skills required.

French reading/games – small groups with the teacher.
Homework (Yrs 1–6) – assistance with French/English homework

If there are not enough numbers interested in an activity the activity will be CANCELLED for the Term.
