

Over the years, the P&C Committee has received many requests from students and staff for financial support to attend and participate in a wide variety of National events as Telopea Park School representatives. With the limited amount of funds available to the P&C, and in order to not create precedents that that cannot later be met, this has resulted in a past P&C policy of turning down all requests of this type. The P&C Committee has long felt that this regular turning down of requests is undesirable. Accordingly, a new policy is drafted as follows.

P&C Recognition and Reward for Excellence

In recognition of excellence in the Telopea Park School student community, the Parents and Citizens Committee have decided to award those students who achieve excellence in their chosen fields, a cash donation of \$100 to help allay the costs of participating in interstate events.

Students must apply for this donation, in writing, to the P&C Committee. The following guidelines will assist the P&C when it considers that the applicants are:

- Representing the ACT in their chosen field (eg. sports, artistic, academic);
- Participating in national events/championships;
- Members of the Telopea Park School community for a minimum of six months;
- Actively pursuing private fund raising activities;
- Required to travel interstate to participate in the national event.

The Secretary will put the application to the next meeting of the P&C Committee, or the Executive of the P&C if there is insufficient time. The decision of the P&C will be final.
