Andrew,

My apologies for failing to meet your deadline, I appreciate the challenges you face and the impost late people (such as me in this case) make on your private time – unfortunately I have been absent on work and was unable to respond in time.

I must first offer my apologies, and that of my wife Pauline Koitka, we are unfortunately unable to attend this Wednesday.

I regret we do not have a lot to offer in regards to an update from the traffic sub-committee for the upcoming committee meeting however I am comfortable we are moving in the right direction.

I was previously provided with an initial point of contact (Mr Tony Gill) in Roads ACT. Following contact with him he has re-directed my inquiries to Robyn Hawkins, Manager in the Traffic Management Section who looks after school safety to follow up and make contact on the issues I have raised. My initial queries were general in nature in order to commence the interaction and I am following up with more detailed concerns and ideas. One key aspect is seeking the engagement of an appropriate TMS representative to meet and hopefully agree to address a forum at the school on the traffic issues.

We have also been engaging in a more 'ad-hoc' approach with a variety of parents looking to gain ideas and confirm what are the higher priority concerns. Aside from the overall parking and traffic flow challenges, other ideas have included the need for additional pedestrian traffic islands (such as on the northern intersection of Telopea Park and New South Wales Crescent) as well as bike lanes/bike paths linking the school and local paths.

I am happy to provide more details if and as required and will look to both attend and provide a more comprehensive update at the next committee meeting.
